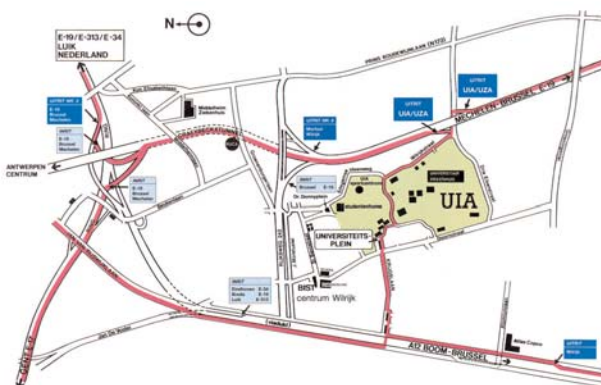

## Call for Posters

Along with invited lectures delivered by eminent specialists, the symposium program will consist of poster sessions to provide a forum for presentation and discussion. Poster sessions will be scheduled to run during lunch break. Presentation in poster sessions will be determined on the basis of an abstract. There is room for about 80 posters.
